



Heat Treatment Checklist

The successful elimination of a bed bug infestation requires good preparation.

REMOVE

- Window Blinds and place on a flat surface in the same room.
- Humans and all pets including birds, fish, reptiles, etc, will have to leave for the entire day.
- Only take items with you that are absolutely necessary. (Wallet, keys, cell-phone.) Purses, backpacks, briefcases and other items should be left in the unit if possible to prevent re-infestation,

PLACE

All of the following items must be placed in containers or totes and placed outside of the treatment area.

- Compressed gases, flammable or combustible chemicals (gasoline, propane, butane, cigarette lighters, light fuel)
- Aerosols and pressurized cans (hairspray, spray-on deodorants, bug sprays, spray paints, asthma inhalers and aerosol cleaning products)
- Ammunition/black powder, butane lighters, lamp oil, fuel for food warmers, solvents, etc.
- Candles, wax figurines, medications, stick deodorant, musical instruments, and indoor plants.
- **Any valuables or any items that you feel may be affected by temperatures up to 145 degrees.**

ORGANIZE

- **All clothing must be off of the floor. All beds must be stripped of sheets, blankets, comforters and box spring skirts. There should be nothing on the beds.**
- It is recommended that you launder all clothes and bed linens and place them in bags outside of the treatment area.
- All clutter must be organized and the floor cleared to allow the technicians to move from room to room safely.
- Remove heavy wall hangings such as mirrors that are hanging on the wall by plastic anchors.
- Clothes and personal items may be left hanging in closets, in drawers or chests, but empty out contents of densely packed areas into open-weave laundry baskets
- Loose papers, newspapers and magazines should be collected and contained to prevent being blown out of place by the high-powered fans

REFRIGERATE

- Fruit, vegetables and chocolate/other food unlikely to withstand the temperature change
- Carbonated beverages or drinks kept under pressure (Plastic soda bottles, wine bottles, canned soda/beer)

OTHER/MISC

- If you have fire protection connected to your alarm system you will need to disarm it for the day.
- Turn off the heating and air conditioning system.
- Drain or deflate bladders of waterbeds or air mattresses.
- Orthopedic devices such as wheelchairs, prosthetic appendages, canes, etc. must remain in the residence (Failure to do so may result in the default of your warranty)
- **When you return to your home you must immediately take the clothing you are wearing off and place them in the dryer on high heat to kill bed bugs that may have been on you when you left your home.**

After treatment you will notice clothing, blankets, and other belongings may not be the way you left them. TRS Extermination heat technicians must rotate these items to achieve even heat distribution throughout the treatment.

I understand that TRS Extermination is not liable for damage to flooring, blinds, or window treatments. And that the temperatures needed to kill bed bugs may distort these items.
